Mat 27:1-66 chiastic structure

- **1A) 27:1** When the morning was come, all the **CHIEF PRIESTS** and **ELDERS** of the people **TOOK COUNSEL** against Yeshua to put Him to death;
 - **1B) 27:2-10 YESHUA BOUND** for trial/ Potter's field for the **BURIAL OF STRANGERS**;
 - **1a) 27:2** And when they had bound Him, they led *Him* away, and **delivered Him to Pontius Pilate** the governor;

central axis) 27:3a Then Judas, who had betrayed Him;

- 2a) 27:3b-10 When he saw that He was condemned, repented;
 - 1a) 27:3b When he saw that He was condemned, repented, and brought back the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders;
 - **1b) 27:4** Saying: I have sinned in that I have betrayed **innocent blood**. And they said: What is that to us? See to that yourself;
 - 1c) 27:5a And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple;

central axis) 27:5b And departed, and went and hanged himself;

- **2c) 27:6a** And the chief priests took the **silver pieces**;
- **2b) 27:6b-8** And said, It is not lawful to put them into the treasury, because it is **the price of blood**. **7** And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, in which to bury strangers. **8** Therefore that field was called, The field of blood, to this day;
- **2a) 27:9-10** Then it was fulfilled which was spoken by Jeremiah the prophet, saying: 'And they took the **thirty pieces of silver**, the price of Him that was valued, whom they of the children of Israel did value; **10** and gave them for the potter's field, as YHVH appointed me;' (Jer 19:1-13, 32:6-9)
- 1C) 27:11A And YESHUA STOOD BEFORE the governor;
 - **1D) 27:11B** And the governor asked Him, saying: Are You **THE KING OF THE JEWS**? And Yeshua said to him: So you say;
 - **1E) 27:12-14** And when **HE WAS ACCUSED BY THE CHIEF PRIESTS AND ELDERS**, He answered nothing. **13** Then Pilate said to Him: Do You not hear how many things they witness against You? **14** And He answered him not a word; so that the governor marvelled greatly;
 - **1F) 27:15-24** They cried for the **RELEASE OF BARABBAS** and the **CRUCIFIXION OF YESHUA**;
 - **1a) 27:15-17** Now at that feast the governor was used to release to the people a prisoner, whomever they would. **16** And they had then a notorius prisoner, called Barabbas. **17** Therefore when they were gathered together, Pilate said to them: **Whom do you**

will that I release to you? Barabbas, or Yeshua who is called Messiah?

- central axis) 27:18 For he knew that it was because of envy that they had delivered Him up;
- 2a) 27:19-24 Which of the two do you will that I release to you? They said: Barabbas. Pilate said to them: What shall I do then with Yeshua who is called Messiah? They all said to him: Let Him be crucified:
 - 1a) 27:19 When he sat down on the judgment seat, his wife sent to him, saying: Have nothing to do with that just Man; for I have suffered many things this day in a dream because of Him;
 - 1b) 27:20 But the chief priests and elders persuaded the multitude that they should ask for Barabbas, and destroy Yeshua;
 - 1c) 27:21-22 The governor answered and said to them: Which of the two do you will that I release to you? They said: Barabbas. 22 Pilate said to them: What shall I do then with Yeshua who is called Messiah? They all said to him: Let Him be crucified;
 - central axis) 27:23a And the governor said: Why, what evil has He done?
 - **2c) 27:23b** But they cried out the more, saying: Let Him be crucified:
 - **2b) 27:24a** When Pilate saw that he could not prevail, but that rather *a tumult had begun*;
 - 2a) 27:24b He took water, and washed his hands before the multitude, saying: I am innocent of the blood of this just Person: see to it yourselves;
- CENTRAL AXIS) 27:25 THEN ANSWERED ALL THE PEOPLE, AND SAID: HIS BLOOD BE ON US, AND ON OUR CHIL-DREN;
- **2F) 27:26** Then he **RELEASED BARABBAS** to them, and when he had flogged Yeshua, **HE DELIVERED HIM TO BE CRUCIFIED**;
- **2E) 27:27-36** The Roman soldiers **MOCK** + **CRUCIFY JESUS**;
 - 1a) 27:27-31b The soliders stripped Him of His garments;
 - 1a) 27:27-28a Then the soldiers of the governor took Yeshua into the common hall, and gathered to Him the whole band of soldiers. 28 And they stripped Him;
 - 1b) 27:28b And put on Him a scarlet robe;
 - 1c) 27:29a And when they had braided a crown of thorns, they put it on His head;
 - 1d) 27:29b And a reed in His right hand;

- central axis) 27:29c-30a And they bowed the knee before Him, and mocked Him, saying, Hail, King of the Jews! 30 And they spit on Him;
- **2d) 27:30b** And took **the reed**;
- 2c) 27:30c And struck Him on the head;
- 2b) 27:31a And after they had mocked Him, they took the robe off from Him;
- 2a) 27:31b And put His own clothing on Him;
- **1b) 27:31c-32** And **led Him away to crucify Him**. **32** And as they came out, they found a man of Cyrene, Simon by name: him they compelled to bear His cross;
- central axis) 27:33-34 And when they had come to a place called Golgotha, that is to say, a place of a skull, 34 they gave Him vinegar to drink mingled with gall: and when He had tasted it, He would not drink;
- 2b) 27:35a And they crucified Him;
- **2a) 27:35b-36** And **divided His garments**, **casting lots**: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet: They divided my garments among them, and for my clothing they cast lots. **36** And sitting down they watched Him there;
- **2D) 27:37** And set up over His head His accusation written: This is Yeshua THE KING OF THE JEWS;
- 2C) 27:38-56 YESHUA STOOD BEFORE heaven and earth upon the cross;
 - 1a) 27:38-44 They mocked;
 - 1a) 27:38 Then there were two thieves crucified with Him, one on the right hand, and another on the left;
 - **1b**) **27:39-40a** And they that passed by reviled Him, wagging their heads, **40** and saying: You who would destroy the temple, and build *it* again in three days, save Yourself. If You are *the Son of God*;
 - 1c) 27:40b Come down from the cross;
 - central axis) 27:41-42a Likewise also the chief priests mocking Him, with the scribes and elders, said: 42 He saved others; Himself He cannot save;
 - **2c) 27:42b** If He is the King of Israel, let Him now **come down from the cross**, and we will believe Him;
 - **2b) 27:43** He trusted in God; let Him deliver Him now, if He will have Him: for He said, I am *the Son of God*;
 - 2a) 27:44 The thieves also, who were crucified with Him, cast the same in His face;
 - **1b) 27:45-46** Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour. **46** And about the ninth hour **Yeshua cried with a**

- **loud voice**, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? That is to say, My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?
- 1c) 27:47 Some of them that stood there, when they heard that, said: This Man calls for Elijah;
- central axis) 27:48 And straightway one of them ran, and took a spunge, and filled *it* with vinegar, and put *it* on a reed, and gave Him to drink;
- **2c) 27:49** The rest said: Let Him be; let us see whether **Elijah will come** to save Him;
- **2b) 27:50** Yeshua, when **He had cried again with a loud voice**, yielded up His spirit;
- **2a) 27:51-56 They marvelled**;
 - 1a) 27:51-54a The Roman centurion watching Yeshua;
 - **1A) 27:51** And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in two from the top to the bottom; and **THE EARTH QUAKED**, and the rocks rent;
 - CENTRAL AXIS) 27:52-53 AND THE GRAVES WERE OPENED; AND MANY BODIES OF THE SAINTS WHICH SLEPT AROSE, 53 AND CAME OUT OF THE GRAVES AFTER HIS RESURRECTION, AND WENT INTO THE HOLY CITY, AND APPEARED TO MANY;
 - **2A) 27:54A** Now when the centurion, and those who were with him, watching Yeshua, saw **THE EARTHQUAKE**, and those things that were done;

central axis) 27:54b They feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God;

- **2a) 27:55-56** And **many women were** there **beholding afar off**, which followed Jesus from Galilee, ministering unto him: **56** among whom was Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James and Joses, and the mother of Zebedee's children;
- **2B) 27:57-61 HIS BODY BOUND** for burial/ Joseph of Arimathea's tomb for the **BURIAL OF YESHUA**;
 - **1a) 27:57-60a** When the evening had come, there came a rich man of Arimathæa, named Joseph, who was himself also Yeshua's disciple: **58** he went to Pilate, and pleaded for the body of Yeshua. Then Pilate commanded the body to be delivered. **59** And when Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth, **60** and laid it in **his own new tomb**, which he had hewn out in the rock;
 - central axis) 27:60b And he rolled a great stone to the door of the sepulchre, and departed;
 - 2a) 27:61 And there was Mary Magdalene, and the other Mary, sitting over against the sepulchre;
- **2A) 27:62-66 CHIEF PRIESTS** and **PHARISEES PLOT** to keep Yeshua in the tomb;

- 1a) 27:62 Now the next day, that followed the day of the preparation, the **chief** priests and Pharisees came together to Pilate, saying;
- **1b) 27:63a** Sir, we remember that **that deceiver** said, while He was yet alive;
- 1c) 27:63b 'After three days I will rise again;'
- central axis) 27:64a Command therefore that the sepulchre be made fast until the third day;
- **2c) 27:64b** Lest His disciples come by night, and steal Him away, and say to the people, '**He is risen from the dead**;'
- **2b) 27:64c** So the **last error** shall be worse than the first;
- **2a) 27:65-66 Pilate said to them**: You have a watch: go your way, make it as fast as you can. **66** So they went, and made the sepulchre fast, sealing the stone, and setting a watch.
