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## Genesis summary by its Torah portions

- 1A) 1:1-6:8** *Bereisheet*: Adam, the son of God/ the **SONS OF ADAM**;
- 1B) 6:9-11:32** *Noach*: Noah **PRESERVES LIFE** through the Flood;
- 1C.1) 12:1-17:27** *Lech lecha*: Abram **DEPARTED FROM HIS FATHER'S HOUSE**;
- 1C.2) 18:1-22:24** *Vayeira*: Isaac: **PROPHETIC TYPE FOR MESSIAH'S 1ST ADVENT**;
- 1D) 23:1-28:9** *Chayei Sarah + Toledoth*: Life of Isaac **REPEATS EVENTS** from the life of Abraham;
- CENTRAL AXIS) 28:10-32:2** *VAYETZE*: YHVH FULFILLS HIS **PROMISE TO JACOB**;
- 2D) 32:3-36:43** *Vayishlach*: Life of Jacob **REPEATS EVENTS** from the life of Abraham + Isaac;
- 2C.1) 37:1-40:23** *Vayeshev*: Joseph + Judah **DEPARTED FROM THEIR FATHER'S HOUSE**;
- 2C.2) 41:1-44:17** *Miketz*: Joseph: **PROPHETIC TYPE FOR MESSIAH'S 2ND ADVENT**;

THEME OF THE BOOK: CREATION and PRESERVATION.

## Exodus summary by its Torah portions

- 1A) 1:1-6:1** *Shemot*: Moses, **DELIVERER FOR ISRAEL PREPARED** and **SENT**;
- 1B) 6:2-13:16** *Va'era + Bo*: **REDEMPTION** from slavery;
- 1C) 13:17-17:16** *Beshalach*: Israel **TESTED** YHVH/ YHVH **TESTED** Israel, to teach them to trust in Him and not in their own works (Sabbath rest)
- 1D) 18:1-20:26** *Yitro*: The **TEN COMMANDMENTS**: We love Him, because He first loved us;

## Leviticus summary by its Torah portions

**2D) 17:1-18:30 {p+sx12+p}** That which cuts off or makes **ABOMINABLE** (*Acharei mot* part two);

**2C) 19:1-20:27** *Kedoshim*: Israel shall **CONSECRATE** the land with holiness for they are the holy people of YHVH;

**2B) 21:1-24:23** *Emor*: The holy **PRIESTHOOD**, **OFFERINGS**, bread, light, feasts, and name of YHVH;

**2A) 25:1-27:34** *Behar + Bechukotai*: Law of **VALUATION** and **REDEMPTION** of things **CONSECRATED** to YHVH.

THEME OF THE BOOK: ATONEMENT.

## Numbers summary by its Torah portions

**1A) 1:1-4:20** *Bamidbar*: The encampment of the **TRIBES** surrounding the Tabernacle of the Testimony, wherein **YHVH DWELLS** above the mercy seat;

**1B) 4:21-7:89** *Naso*: The **PRIESTLY SERVICE AND BLESSING**;

**1C) 8:1-12:16** *Beha'alotecha*: Journey to the promised land, but **COMPLAINTS** hinder;

**1D) 13:1-15:41** *Shelah lekha*: The **UNBELIEVING GENERATION** despised YHVH's word and will be cut off;

**CENTRAL AXIS) 16:1-18:32** *Korah*: **HOLY GIFTS + TITHES BELONG TO THE PRIESTHOOD**;

**2D) 19:1-22:1** *Chukat*: The **BELIEVING GENERATION** replaced those who died in the wilderness;

**2C) 22:2-25:9** *Balak*: Journey to the promised land, but **DISOBEDIENCE** hinders;

**2B) 25:10-29:40** *Pinchas*: The **PRIESTHOOD** of Yeshua by type **ESTABLISHES THE COVENANT OF PEACE**;

**2A) 30:1-36:13** *Matot + Masei*: That the inheritance of the **TRIBES** may be gained and retained, for **YHVH DWELLS** in the midst of Israel.

THEME OF THE BOOK: INHERITANCE by FAITH.

## Deuteronomy summary by its Torah portions

The chiastic structure I have been able to uncover for Deuteronomy does not follow neat parashah divisions as the other books do. Although there may be another structure for Deuteronomy besides this one, which will be uncovered at some point in the future.

**1A) 1:1-3:29 {sx6+p}** Unbelief will not possess the land, but **JOSHUA** (Yeshua by type) will cause Israel to inherit it;

**1B) 4:1-5:5 INTRODUCTION** to the Commandments;

**1C) 5:6-5:21** The **TEN COMMANDMENTS**;

**CENTRAL AXIS) 5:22-6:3 {p}** **YHVH'S VOICE SPOKE THESE COMMANDMENTS, SO HEAR + PAY HEED + OBSERVE THEM**;

**2C) 6:4-26:15** The explanation of the **TEN COMMANDMENTS**;

**2B) 26:16-30:20 CONCLUSION** to the Commandments;

**2A) 31:1-34:12** *Vayelech + Ha'azinu + Vezot haberakhah*: **JOSHUA** (Yeshua by type) will lead Israel to cross over the Jordan.

THEME OF THE BOOK: OBEDIENCE.

The rest of Hebrew Scripture reports on obedience, sin, repentance, and return.

2A) MAT 1:1-JOH 21:25 RE-CREATION: Resurrection life of Messiah Yeshua.

The rest of Greek Scripture reports on a believer's new resurrection life in Messiah Yeshua.

Rev 21:1 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth;

Rev 22:2 The tree of life.
