- 1A) 22:25-23:19 THE COMMANDMENTS OF YHVH WHICH EXPLAIN HIS WAY OF WALKING;
 - **1a.1) 22:25-27 {s}** If you lend money to any of My people, **even to the poor with you**, you shall not be to him as a creditor; neither shall you lay interest on him. If you at all take your neighbour's garment in pledge, you shall restore it to him by the going down of the sun; for that is his only covering, it is his garment for his skin; within what shall he sleep? And it shall come to pass, when he cries to Me, that I will hear; for I am gracious;
 - 1a.2) 22:28 You shall not revile God, nor curse a ruler of your people;
 - **1a.3) 22:29-30 You shall not delay to offer of the fulness of your harvest**, and of the outflow of your presses. The firstborn of your sons you shall give to Me. Likewise you shall do with your oxen, and with your sheep; seven days it shall be with its mother; on the eighth day you shall give it to Me;
 - 1a.4) 22:31 {s} And you shall be holy men to Me; therefore you shall not eat any flesh that is torn by beasts in the field; you shall cast it to the dogs;
 - 1b.1) 23:1a You shall not utter a false report;

- **1b.2) 23:1b-2** Nor put your hand with the wicked to be an unrighteous witness. You shall not follow a multitude to do evil; **neither shall you** bear witness in a cause to turn aside after a multitude to **pervert justice**;
- 1c) 23:3 {s} Neither shall you favor a poor man in his cause;
- central axis) 23:4-5 {s+s} If you meet your enemy's ox or his donkey going astray, you shall surely bring it back to him again. If you see the donkey of him that hates you lying under its burden, you shall forbear to pass by him; you shall surely release it with him;
- 2c) 23:6 You shall not subvert the judgment of your poor in his cause; 2b.1) 23:7a Keep far from you a false matter;
- **2b.2) 23:7b-9** You shall take no bribe, for **it perverts the words of the righteous**;
 - 1a) 23:7b And the innocent and righteous do not slay; for I will not justify the wicked;
 - central axis) 23:8 And you shall take no bribe; for a bribe blinds those who have sight, and perverts the words of the righteous;
 - 2a) 23:9 And a stranger you shall not oppress; for you know the heart of a stranger, seeing you were strangers in the land of Egypt;
- 2a.1) 23:10-12 The Sabbatical year provides for the poor;
 - 1a) 23:10-11a And six years you shall sow your land, and gather in its increase; but the seventh year you shall let it rest and lie fallow;
 - **1b) 23:11b That the poor of your people may eat**; and what they leave the beast of the field shall eat. In like manner you shall deal with your vineyard, and with your oliveyard;
 - 2a) 23:12a Six days you shall do your work, but on the seventh day you shall rest;
 - **2b) 23:12b That your ox and your donkey may have rest**, and the son of your handmaid, and the stranger, may be refreshed;
- 2a.2) 23:13 And in all things that I have said to you take heed; and make no mention of the name of other gods, neither let it be heard out of your mouth;
- **2a.3) 23:14-19a** Three times you shall keep a feast to Me in the year. The feast of unleavened bread you shall keep; seven days you shall eat unleavened bread, as I commanded you, at the time appointed in the month of Abib--for in it you came out from Egypt; and **none shall appear before Me empty**; and the feast of harvest, the firstfruits of your labors, which you sow in the field; and the feast of ingathering, at the end of the year, when you gather in your labors out of the field.  - **1a) 23:20** Behold, **I send an angel before you**, to keep you by the way, and **to bring you into the place which I have prepared**;
 - **1b) 23:21a** Take heed of him, and **hearken to his voice**; do not be rebellious against him;
 - central axis) 23:21b For he will not pardon your transgression; for My name is in him;

 - 1c) 23:28c The Hivite, the Canaanite, and the Hittite, from before you;
 - 1d) 23:29-30b Lest the land become desolate;
