- 1a) 27:1-2 And it came to pass, that when Isaac was old, and his eyes were dim, so that he could not see, he called Esau his elder son, and said to him: My son; and he said to him: Here am I. 2 And he said: Behold now, I am old, I know not the day of my death;
- central axis) 27:3-4a Now therefore take, I pray you, your weapons, your quiver and your bow, and go out to the field, and bring me venison; 4 and make me savory food, such as I love, and bring it to me, that I may eat;

  - CENTRAL AXIS) 27:5C AND ESAU WENT TO THE FIELD TO HUNT FOR VENISON, AND TO BRING IT;
  - 2B) 27:6A And REBEKAH SPOKE TO JACOB HER SON, saying;
  - 2A) 27:6B-7 Behold, I HEARD your father speak to Esau your brother, saying: 7 Bring me venison, and make me savory food, that I may eat, and bless you before YHVH before my death;

- CENTRAL AXIS) 27:15-16 AND REBEKAH TOOK THE CHOICEST GARMENTS OF ESAU HER ELDER SON, WHICH WERE WITH HER IN THE HOUSE, AND PUT THEM ON JACOB HER YOUNGER SON. 16 AND SHE PUT THE SKINS OF THE KIDS OF THE GOATS ON HIS HANDS, AND UPON THE SMOOTH OF HIS NECK;
- 2C) 27:17A And she gave the SAVORY FOOD and the bread,
- 2B) 27:17B Which SHE HAD PREPARED;
- 2A) 27:17B INTO THE HAND OF HER SON JACOB;

# 1C) 27:18-25 JACOB CAME IN TO THE PRESENCE OF ISAAC HIS FATHER;

- **1a.1) 27:18-19a** And he came to his father, and said: My father; and he said: Here am I; who are you, my son? 19 And Jacob said to his father: I am Esau your first-born;

- 1b) 28:1-2 And Isaac called Jacob, and blessed him, and charged him, and said to him: You shall not take a wife of the daughters of Canaan. 2 Arise, go to Paddan-aram, to the house of Bethuel your mother's father; and take you a wife from there of the daughters of Laban your mother's brother;

central axis) 28:3-4 And God Almighty bless you, and make you fruitful, and multiply you, that you may be a congregation of peoples; 4 and give
