What is lawful on the Sabbath.



- 1A) 2:23-26 What is not LAWFUL ON THE SABBATH DAY;
 - 1a) 2:23 He was going on the Sabbath day through the grain fields; and His disciples began, as they went, to pluck the ears of grain;
 - central axis) 2:24 The Pharisees said to Him: Behold, why do they do that which is not lawful on the Sabbath day?
 - 2a) 2:25-26 He said to them: Did you never read what David did when he had need and was hungry—he, and those who were with him? 26 How he entered into God's house at the time of Abiathar the high priest, and ate the show bread, which is not lawful to eat except for the priests, and gave also to those who were with him?
 - CENTRAL AXIS) 2:27-28 HE SAID TO THEM, THE SABBATH WAS MADE FOR MAN, NOT MAN FOR THE SABBATH. 28 THEREFORE THE SON OF MAN IS LORD EVEN OF THE SABBATH:

2A) 3:1-6 Is it LAWFUL ON THE SABBATH DAY;

- **1a.1) 3:1** He entered again into the synagogue, and there was a man there who had his hand withered;
- 1a.2) 3:2 They watched Him, whether He would heal him on the Sabbath day, that they might accuse Him;
- 1b) 3:3 He said to the man who had his hand withered: Stand up;
- central axis) 3:4-5a He said to them: Is it lawful on the Sabbath day to do good or to do harm? To save a life or to kill? But they were silent. 5 When He had looked around at them with anger, being grieved at the hardening of their hearts;
- 2b) 3:5b He said to the man: Stretch out your hand;
- **2a.1) 3:5c** He stretched it out, and **his hand was restored** as healthy as the other;
- 2a.2) 3:6 The Pharisees went out, and immediately conspired with the Herodians against Him, how they might destroy Him.
