Mark 11:1-33 Chiasm

1A) 11:1-11 The **SON OF DAVID** entered the city and Temple through the prince's gate and is proclaimed to be the **MESSIAH**;

1a) 11:1-8 And when they came near to Jerusalem, **unto Bethphage and Bethany**, at the mount of Olives, He sent forth two of His disciples, 2 and said unto them: Go your way into the village over against you: and as soon as you are entered into it, you shall find a colt tied, whereon man has never sat; loose him, and bring him. 3 And if any man say unto you: Why do you do this? Say that the Lord has need of him; and straightaway he will send him hither. 4 And they went their way, and found the colt tied by the door outside in a place where two ways met; and they loosed him. 5 And certain of them that stood there said unto them: What are you doing, loosing the colt? 6 And they said unto them even as Yeshua had commanded: and they let them go. 7 And they brought the colt to Yeshua, and cast their garments on him; and He sat upon him. 8 And many spread their garments in the way: and others cut down branches off the trees, and strew them in the way;

1b) 11:9a And they that went before, and they that followed, cried, saying: **Hosanna**;

1c) 11:9b Blessed is He **that comes in the name of the Lord**;

central axis) 11:10a Blessed is the kingdom of our father David;

2c) 11:10b **That comes in the name of the Lord**;

2b) 11:10c **Hosanna** in the highest;

2a) 11:11 And Yeshua entered into Jerusalem, and into the temple: and when He had looked round about upon all things, and now the evening had come, He went out **unto Bethany** with the twelve;

1B) 11:12-14 And on the morrow, when they had come from Bethany, He was hungry: 13 and seeing a **FIG TREE** afar off having leaves, He came, if it happened that He might find any thing thereon: and when He came to it, He found nothing but leaves; for the time of figs was not yet. 14 And Yeshua answered and said unto it: No man eat fruit of you hereafter for ever. And His disciples heard it;

CENTRAL AXIS) 11:15-19 **YESHUA CLEANSSES THE TEMPLE**;

1a) 11:15a And they came to Jerusalem: and Yeshua went into the temple;

1b) 11:15b-16 And began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and **overthrew the tables of the moneychangers**, and the seats of them that sold doves; 16 and would not suffer that any man should carry any vessel through the temple;

central axis) 11:17a And He taught, saying unto them: Is it not written,
My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer?

2b) 11:17b-18 But you have made it a **den of thieves**. 18 And the scribes
and chief priests heard it, and sought how they might destroy Him:
for they feared Him, because all the people were astonished at His
doctrine;

2a) 11:19 And when evening had come, He went out of the city;

2B) 11:20-26 The lesson of the **FIG TREE**;

1a) 11:20-21 And in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree
dried up from the roots. 21 And Peter calling to remembrance said unto
Him: Master, behold, the fig tree which You cursed is **withered away**;

1b) 11:22-23 And Yeshua answering said unto them: Have faith in God. 23
For truly I say unto you, that whosoever shall say unto this mountain:
Be removed, and be cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart,
but shall **believe** that those things which he says shall come to pass; **he
shall have whatsoever he says**;

central axis) 11:24a Therefore I say unto you, whatsoever things you
desire, when you pray;

2b) 11:24b **Believe** that you receive them, and **you shall have them**;

2a) 11:25-26 And when you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything
against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you
your trespasses. 26 But if you do not forgive, **neither will your Father
which is in heaven forgive your trespasses**;

2A) 11:27-33 **YESHUA'S AUTHORITY** questioned;

1a) 11:27-28 And they came again to Jerusalem: and as He was walking in the
temple, there came to Him the chief priests, and the scribes, and the
elders, 28 and said unto Him: **By what authority do You do these things?**
And who gave You this authority to do these things?

1b) 11:29 And Yeshua answered and said unto them: I will also ask of you one
question, and **answer Me**, and I will tell you by what authority I do these
things;

1c) 11:30a The baptism of John, was it **from heaven**, or **of men**?

central axis) 11:30b Answer Me;

2c) 11:31-32 And they reasoned with themselves, saying: If we shall say, **From
heaven**; He will say, Why then did you not believe him? 32 But if we shall
say, **Of men**; they feared the people: for all men counted John, that he
was a prophet indeed;

2b) 11:33a And **they answered** and said unto Yeshua, We cannot tell;

2a) 11:33b And Yeshua answering said unto them: Neither do I tell you **by
what authority I do these things**.
