## 1A) 6:8-7:10 THE OFFERINGS and their CONSECRATED PORTIONS FOR THE PRIESTS;

1a) 6:8-23 This is the law of the **voluntary burnt offerings** (*olah* + *minchah*);

1a) 6:8-11 And YHVH spoke unto Moses, saying: 9 Command Aaron and his sons, saying: **This is the law of the burnt offering** *olah*: it is that which goes up on its firewood upon the altar all night unto the morning; and the fire of the altar shall be kept burning on it. 10 And the priest shall put on his linen garment, and his linen breeches shall he put upon his flesh; and he shall take up the ashes of which the fire has consumed the **burnt offering** *olah* on the altar, and he shall put them beside the altar. 11 And he shall put off his garments, and put on other garments, and carry forth the ashes outside the camp unto a clean place;

1b) 6:12a And the **fire upon the altar shall be kept burning** on it, it shall not go out; central axis) 6:12b And the priest shall kindle wood on it every morning; and he shall lay the burnt offering *olah* in order upon it, and shall make smoke on it the fat of the peace offerings *shelem*;

2b) 6:13 **Fire shall be kept burning upon the altar** continually; it shall not go out; {s}

2a) 6:14-23 **This is the law of the grain offering** *minchah*;

1a.1) 6:14-15a And **this is the law of the grain offering** *minchah*: the sons of Aaron shall offer it before YHVH, in front of the altar. 15 And he shall take up there from his handful, of the fine flour of the grain offering *minchah*, and of its oil, and all the frankincense which is upon the grain offering *minchah*;

1a.2) 6:15b And shall **make** its memorial part **smoke** upon the altar for a sweet aroma unto YHVH;

1a.3) 6:16a And that which is left of it, Aaron and his sons **shall eat**;

1b) 6:16b It shall be eaten **without leaven** in a holy place;

central axis) 6:16c **In the court of the tent of meeting they shall eat it**;

2b) 6:17-18 It shall **not** be baked **with leaven**. I have given it as their portion of My offerings made by fire *ishshah*; it is most holy, as the sin offering *chattath*, and as the trespass offering *asham*. 18 Every male among the children of Aaron may eat of it, as his due for ever throughout your generations, from the offerings of YHVH made by fire *ishshah*; whatever touches them shall be holy; {p}

2a.1) 6:19-22a And YHVH spoke unto Moses, saying: 20 **This is the offering** *qorban of Aaron and of his sons*, which they shall offer unto YHVH in the day when he is anointed: the tenth part of an ephah of fine flour for a **grain offering** *minchah* perpetually, half of it in the morning, and half of it in the evening. 21 On a griddle it shall be made with oil; when it is soaked, you shall bring it in; in broken pieces you shall offer the **grain offering** *minchah* for a sweet aroma unto YHVH. 22 And the anointed priest that shall be in his place from among his sons shall offer it, it is his due for ever;

2a.2) 6:22b-23a It shall be **wholly made to smoke** unto YHVH. 23 And every grain offering *minchah* of the priest shall be **wholly made to smoke**;

2a.3) 6:23b It **shall not be eaten**; {p}

1b) 6:24-30 {p} The law of the sin offering *chattath* **which the priest shall eat**;

1a) 6:24-25a And YHVH spoke unto Moses, saying: 25 Speak unto Aaron and to his sons, saying: This is **the law of the sin offering** *chattath*: in the place where the burnt offering *olah* is killed shall the sin offering *chattath* be killed before YHVH;

1b) 6:25b **It is most holy**;

1c) 6:26a The priest that offers it for sin **shall eat it**;

1d) 6:26b **In a holy place** shall it be eaten, in the court of the tent of meeting;

central axis) 6:27a **Whatever shall touch its flesh shall be holy**;

2d) 6:27b-28 And when there is sprinkled of its blood upon any garment, you shall wash that on which it was sprinkled **in a holy place**. 28 But the earthen vessel in which it is boiled shall be broken; and if it is boiled in a bronze vessel, it shall be scoured, and rinsed in water;

2c) 6:29a Every male among the priests **may eat of it**;

2b) 6:29b **It is most holy**;

2a) 6:30 And **no sin offering** *chattath*, in which any of the blood is brought into the tent of meeting to make atonement in the Holy Place, shall be eaten; it shall be burnt with fire; {p}

2b) 7:1-7 **The law of the trespass offering** *asham* **which the priests shall eat**;

1a) 7:1-5a And **this is the law** of the trespass offering *asham*: it is most holy. 2 In the place where they kill the burnt offering *olah* shall they kill the trespass offering *asham*: and its blood shall be dashed against the altar round about. 3 And he shall offer of it all its fat: the fat tail, and the fat that covers the inward parts, 4 and the two kidneys, and the fat that is on them, which is by the loins, and the lobe above the liver, which he shall take away with the kidneys. 5 And the priest shall make them smoke upon the altar for an offering made by fire *ishshah* unto YHVH;

1b) 7:5b It is a **trespass offering** *asham*;

central axis) 7:6 Every male among the priests may eat of it; it shall be eaten in a holy place; it is most holy;

2b) 7:7a As is the sin offering *chattath*, so is the **trespass offering** *asham*;

2a) 7:7b **There is one law for them**; the priest that makes atonement with it, he shall have it;

2a) 7:8-10 {p} What is the priests of the **voluntary burnt offerings** (*olah* + *minchah*);

1a) 7:8 And the priest that offers any man's burnt offering *olah*, even that priest shall have for himself the skin of the burnt offering *olah* **which he has offered**;

central axis) 7:9a And every grain offering *minchah* that is baked in the oven, and all that is dressed in the stewing pan, and on the griddle;

2a) 7:9b-10 Shall be **the priest's who offers it**. 10 And every grain offering *minchah*, mingled with oil, or dry, shall all the sons of Aaron have, one as well as another; {p}

1B) 7:11-21 {p} **THE LAW OF THE PEACE OFFERING** that must be eaten;

1a) 7:11-16 And this is the law of the sacrifice *zebach* of peace offerings *shelem*, which one may offer unto YHVH. 12 If he offer it for a thanksgiving, then he shall offer with the sacrifice *zebach* of thanksgiving unleavened cakes mingled with oil, and unleavened wafers spread with oil, and cakes mingled with oil, of fine flour soaked. 13 With cakes of leavened bread he shall present his offering *qorban* with the sacrifice *zebach* of his peace offerings *shelem* for thanksgiving. 14 And of it he shall present one out of each offering *qorban* for a heave

offering *terumah* unto YHVH; it shall be the priest's that dashes the blood of the peace offerings *shelem* against the altar. 15 And the flesh of the sacrifice *zebach* of his peace offerings *shelem* for thanksgiving **shall be eaten** on the day of his offering *qorban*; he shall not leave any of it until the morning. 16 But if the sacrifice *zebach* of his offering *qorban* is a vow, or a freewill offering *nedabah*, it **shall be eaten** on the day that he offers his sacrifice *zebach*; and on the morrow that which remains of it may be eaten;

**1b) 7:17** But that which remains of the flesh of the sacrifice *zebach* on the third day **shall be burnt with fire**;

central axis) 7:18 And if any of the flesh of the sacrifice *zebach* of his peace offerings *shelem* is at all eaten on the third day, it shall not be accepted, neither shall it be imputed unto him who offers it; it shall be an abhorred thing, and the soul that eats of it shall bear his iniquity;

**2b) 7:19a** And the flesh that touches any unclean thing shall not be eaten; it **shall be burnt with fire**;

**2a) 7:19b-21** As for the flesh, every one that is clean **may eat of it**;

**1a) 7:19b-20** And as for the flesh, every one that is clean may eat of it. 20 But the soul that **eats of the flesh of the sacrifice *zebach* of peace offerings *shelem***, that **pertain unto YHVH**, having his uncleanness upon him, **that soul shall be cut off** from his people;

central axis) 7:21a And when any one shall touch any unclean thing, whether it is the uncleanness of man, or an unclean beast, or any unclean detestable thing;

**2a) 7:21b** And **eat of the flesh of the sacrifice *zebach* of peace offerings *shelem***, which **pertain unto YHVH**, **that soul shall be cut off** from his people; {p}

**CENTRAL AXIS) 7:22-27** And YHVH spoke unto Moses, saying: **23** Speak unto the children of Israel, saying: **YOU SHALL EAT NO FAT**, of ox, or sheep, or goat. **24** And the fat of that which dies of itself, and the fat of that which is torn of beasts, may be used for any other service; but you shall in no way eat of it. **25** For whoever eats the fat of the beast, of which men present an offering made by fire *ishshah* unto YHVH, even the soul that eats it shall be cut off from his people. **26** **AND YOU SHALL EAT NO MANNER OF BLOOD**, whether it be of winged creature or of beast, in any of your dwellings. **27** Whoever it is that eats any blood, **THAT SOUL SHALL BE CUT OFF** from his people;

**2B) 7:28-34 THE LAW OF THE PEACE OFFERING**;

**1a) 7:28-29** And YHVH spoke unto Moses, saying: 29 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying: He that offers **his sacrifice *zebach* of peace offerings *shelem*** unto YHVH shall bring his offering *qorban* unto YHVH out of his sacrifice *zebach* of peace offerings *shelem*;

**1b) 7:30** His own hands shall bring the offerings of YHVH made by fire *ishshah*: the fat with the breast he shall bring, that the breast may be waved for a **wave offering *tenupah*** before YHVH;

central axis) 7:31 And the priest shall make the fat smoke upon the altar; but the breast shall be Aaron's and his sons';

2b) 7:32-33 And the right thigh you shall give unto the priest for a **heave offering** *terumah* out of your sacrifices of peace offerings *shelem*. 33 He among the sons of Aaron, that offers the blood of the peace offerings *shelem*, and the fat, shall have the right thigh for a portion;

2a) 7:34 For the breast of waving and the thigh of heaving I have taken from the children of Israel out of **their sacrifices of peace offerings** *shelem*, and have given them unto Aaron the priest and unto his sons as his due for ever from the children of Israel;

**2A) 7:35-8:36 THE OFFERINGS** and the **CONSECRATED PRIESTHOOD** who offers them;

1a) 7:35-36 This is the **consecrated portion** of Aaron, and the **consecrated portion** of his sons, out of the offerings of YHVH made by fire, in the day **when they were presented to minister** unto YHVH in the priest's office; 36 which YHVH commanded to be given them from the children of Israel, in the day that they were anointed. It is his due for ever throughout their generations;

central axis) 7:37-38 This is the law of the burnt offering *olah*, of the grain offering *minchah*, and of the sin offering *chattath*, and of the trespass offering *asham*, and of the consecration offering, and of the sacrifice of peace offerings *shelem*; 38 which YHVH commanded Moses in Mount Sinai, in the day that he commanded the children of Israel to present their offerings unto YHVH, in the wilderness of Sinai; {p}

2a) 8:1-36 {s} **Consecration** of the priesthood **on the day when Moses presented them to minister**;

1a.1) 8:1-9a And YHVH spoke unto Moses, saying: 2 Take Aaron and his sons with him, and the garments, and the anointing oil, and the bull of the sin offering *chattath*, and the two rams, and the basket of unleavened bread; 3 and assemble all the congregation at the door of the tent of meeting. 4 And Moses did as YHVH commanded him; and the congregation was assembled at the door of the tent of meeting. 5 And Moses said unto the congregation: **This is the thing which YHVH has commanded to be done**. 6 And Moses brought Aaron and his sons, and washed them with water. 7 And he put upon him the tunic, and girded him with the girdle, and clothed him with the robe, and put the ephod upon him, and he girded him with the skilfully woven band of the ephod, and bound it to him. 8 And he placed the breastplate upon him; and in the breastplate he put the Urim and the Thummim. 9 And he set the turban upon his head; and upon the turban, in front, he set the golden plate, the holy crown;

1a.2) 8:9b As **YHVH commanded Moses**;

1b.1) 8:10 And **Moses took the anointing oil**, and anointed the tabernacle and all that was within it, and sanctified them;

1b.2) 8:11-13 And he sprinkled upon the altar **seven times**, and anointed the altar and all its vessels, and the laver and its base, to sanctify them. 12 And he poured of the anointing oil upon Aaron's head, and anointed him, to sanctify him. 13 And Moses

brought Aaron's sons, and clothed them with tunics, and girded them with girdles, and bound turbans upon them; as YHVH commanded Moses;  
central axis) 8:14-29 The sin, burnt, and consecration offerings presented;

1) 8:14-17 The bull of the sin offering *chattath* presented;

8:14 And the bull of the sin offering *chattath* was brought; and Aaron and his sons laid their hands upon the head of the bull of the sin offering *chattath*. 15 And when it was slain, Moses took the blood, and put it upon the horns of the altar round about with his finger, and purified the altar, and poured out the remaining blood at the base of the altar, and sanctified it, to make atonement for it. 16 And he took all the fat that was upon the inward parts, and the lobe of the liver, and the two kidneys, and their fat, and Moses made it smoke upon the altar. 17 But the bull, and its skin, and its flesh, and its offal, were burnt with fire outside the camp; as YHVH commanded Moses;

2) 8:18-21 The ram of the burnt offering *olah* presented;

8:18 And the ram of the burnt offering *olah* was presented; and Aaron and his sons laid their hands upon the head of the ram. 19 And when it was killed, Moses dashed the blood against the altar round about. 20 And when the ram was cut into its pieces, Moses made the head, and the pieces, and the suet smoke. 21 And when the inward parts and the legs were washed with water, Moses made the whole ram smoke upon the altar; it was a burnt offering *olah* for a sweet aroma; it was an offering made by fire unto YHVH; as YHVH commanded Moses;

3) 8:22-29 The ram of the consecration offering *milloo* presented;

8:22 And the other ram was presented, the ram of consecration *milloo*, and Aaron and his sons laid their hands upon the head of the ram. 23 And when it was slain, Moses took of its blood, and put it upon the tip of Aaron's right ear, and upon the thumb of his right hand, and upon the great toe of his right foot. 24 And Aaron's sons were brought, and Moses put of the blood upon the tip of their right ear, and upon the thumb of their right hand, and upon the great toe of their right foot; and Moses dashed the blood against the altar round about. 25 And he took the fat, and the fat tail, and all the fat that was upon the inward parts, and the lobe of the liver, and the two kidneys, and their fat, and the right thigh. 26 And out of the basket of unleavened bread, that was before YHVH, he took one unleavened cake, and one cake of oiled bread, and one wafer, and placed them on the fat, and upon the right thigh. 27 And he put the whole upon the hands of Aaron, and upon the hands of his sons, and waved them for a wave offering before YHVH. 28 And Moses took them from off their hands, and made them smoke on the altar upon the burnt offering *olah*; they were a consecration offering *milloo* for a sweet aroma; it was an offering made by fire unto YHVH. 29 And Moses took the breast, and waved it for a wave offering before YHVH; it was Moses' portion of the ram of consecration; as YHVH commanded Moses;

1b.1) 8:30-32 And Moses took of the anointing oil, and of the blood which was upon the altar, and sprinkled it upon Aaron, and upon his garments, and upon his sons, and upon his sons' garments with him, and sanctified Aaron, and his garments, and his

sons, and his sons' garments with him. 31 And Moses said unto Aaron and to his sons: Boil the flesh at the door of the tent of meeting; and there eat it and the bread that is in the basket of consecration, as I commanded, saying: Aaron and his sons shall eat it. 32 And that which remains of the flesh and of the bread you shall burn with fire;

**1b.2) 8:33** And you shall not go out from the door of the tent of meeting **seven days**, until the days of your consecration are fulfilled; for He shall consecrate you seven days;

**2a.1) 8:34-35** As has been done this day, **so YHVH has commanded to do**, to make atonement for you. 35 And at the door of the tent of meeting you shall abide day and night seven days, and keep the charge of YHVH, that you die not; for so I am commanded;

**2a.2) 8:36** And Aaron and his sons did all the things which **YHVH commanded by the hand of Moses**. {s}
