



Rev 14:6-16:21 Judgments of Seven Bowls of Wrath

1A) 14:6-15:4 The Son of Man reaps the harvest of the earth / an angel reaps the grapes of **THE WRATH OF GOD**;

1a) 14:6-7 And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting Gospel to preach to them who dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and tribe, and tongue, and people, 7 saying with a loud voice, ‘**Fear God, and give glory to Him**; for **the hour of His judgment is come**, and **worship Him** who made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters;’

1b.1) 14:8 And there followed another angel, saying, ‘Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she made all nations **drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication**;’

1b.2) 14:9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, ‘If any man **worships the beast and his image**, and **receives his mark** in his forehead, or in his hand;

1b.1 repeated) 14:10-11a The same **shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God**, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of His indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb; **11** and the smoke of their torment ascends up for ever and ever; and they have no rest day nor night;

1b.2 repeated) 14:11b Who **worship the beast and his image**, and whoever **receives the mark of his name**;

1b.3) 14:12-13 Here is the patience of the saints; here are those who keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Yeshua.’ **13** And I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, ‘Write, “Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from here on;” ‘Yes,’ says the Spirit, ‘that they may rest from their labors; and their works follow them;’ [i.e., **Those who die in the Lord, and rest**];

1c) 14:14-16 The Son of Man **reaps the harvest of the earth**;

2c) 14:17-19a An angel **reaps the grapes of wrath**;

2b.1) 14:19b-15:1 The great **winepress of the wrath of God**;

2b.2) 15:2 Those who had **gotten victory over the beast, and over his image, mark**, and number;

2b.3) 15:3a And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying; [i.e., **Those who had gotten victory over the beast, who have died in the Lord, and are at rest**];

2a) 15:3b-4 ‘Great and marvellous are Your works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are Your ways, You King of saints. **4 Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name?** For You alone are holy; for **all nations shall come and worship** before You; **for Your judgments are made manifest**;’

1B) 15:1-16:1 Seven angels with seven last plagues, for in them the wrath of God **IS FINISHED**;

1a) 15:1 And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous, **seven angels having the seven last plagues**; for in them **the wrath of God** is finished;

1b) 15:2a And I saw as it were a **sea of glass** mingled with fire; **central axis) 15:2b** And those who had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name;

2b) 15:2c-4 Stand on the sea of glass;

1a) 15:2c-3 Stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God. **3** And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, ‘Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty; **just** and true are Your ways, You King of saints;

central axis) 15:4a *Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You alone are holy; for all nations shall come and worship before You;*

2a) 15:4b For Your **judgments** are made manifest;’

2a) 15:5-16:1 The **seven angels with the seven plagues** were given seven golden bowls full of **the wrath of God**;

1a) 15:5-6 And after that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened; **6** and the **seven angels** came out of the temple, **having the seven plagues**, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their chests girded with golden belts;

central axis) 15:7 *And one of the four beings gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the wrath of God, who lives for ever and ever;*

2a) 15:8-16:1 And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from His power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till **the seven plagues of the seven angels** were fulfilled. **16:1** And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, ‘Go your ways, and pour out the bowls of the wrath of God on the earth;’

1C) 16:2-12 The first six **BOWLS POURED OUT**;

1a) 16:2-4 And **the first** went, and **poured out his bowl** on the earth; and there fell a foul and grievous sore on the men who had the mark of the beast, and on them who worshiped his image. **3** And **the second angel poured out his bowl** on the sea; and it became as the blood of a dead man; and every living soul died in the sea. **4** And **the third angel poured out his bowl** on the rivers and fountains of waters; and they became blood;

1b) 16:5 And I heard the angel of the waters say, ‘**You are righteous**, O Lord, who is, and was, and shall be, **because You have thus judged**;

central axis) 16:6 For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and
You have given them blood to drink; for they are worthy;

2b) 16:7 And I heard another out of the altar say, ‘Even so, Lord God Almighty,
true and righteous are Your judgments;

2a) 16:8-12 The fourth through sixth angels pour out their bowls;

1a) 16:8 And the *fourth angel poured out his bowl* on the sun; and power
was given to him to scorch men with fire;

1b) 16:9 9 And men were scorched with great heat, and *blasphemed the
name of God*, which has power over these plagues: and they *did not
repent*, to give Him glory;

*central axis) 16:10a And the fifth angel poured out his bowl on the
throne of the beast; and his kingdom was full of darkness;*

2b) 16:10b-11 And they gnawed their tongues for pain, 11 and *blasphemed
the God of heaven* because of their pains and their sores, and *did not
repent* of their deeds;

2a) 16:12 And the *sixth angel poured out his bowl* on the great river
Euphrates; and its water was dried up, that the way of the kings of the
east might be prepared;

1D) 16:13-14 And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs come out of the mouth of the
dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false
prophet. 14 For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, which go forth to
the kings of the earth and of the whole world, **TO GATHER THEM** to the
battle of that great day of God Almighty; [i.e., *The third interval period: three frog
spirits gather the kings to the battle*];

CENTRAL AXIS) 16:15 ‘BEHOLD, I COME AS A THIEF. BLESSED IS HE
WHO WATCHES, AND KEEPS HIS GARMENTS, LEST HE WALK
NAKED, AND THEY SEE HIS SHAME;’

2D) 16:16 And **HE GATHERED THEM TOGETHER** to a place called in the
Hebrew tongue Armageddon;

2C) 16:17A And the seventh angel **POURED OUT HIS BOWL** into the air;

2B) 16:17B And there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne,
saying, ‘It **IS DONE**;’

2A) 16:18-21 Babylon the great remembered before God, to give her **THE CUP OF THE
WINE OF THE FIERCENESS OF HIS WRATH**;

1a) 16:18 The **great earthquake**;

1a) 16:18a And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a
great earthquake,

central axis) 16:18b Such as was not since men were on the earth;

- 2a) 16:18c** So **mighty an earthquake**, and **so great**;
- 1b) 16:19a** And the great city was divided into three parts, and **the cities of the nations fell**;
- (central axis) **16:19b** And great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give to her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of His wrath;
- 2b) 16:20** And **every island fled away**, and **the mountains were not found**;
- 2a) 16:21** And there fell on men a great hail out of heaven, every stone about the weight of a talent; and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for **the plague was exceedingly great**.
