



## Rev 17:1-19:3 The Restoration and its Effects

**1A) 17:1-18:8** The **JUDGMENT OF THE GREAT HARLOT** when she is utterly burned with fire;

**1a) 17:1a** And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven bowls, and talked with me, saying to me, 'Come here; I will show to you **the judgment of the great harlot**;

**1b.1) 17:1b** **Who sits on many waters**;

**1b.2) 17:2** With whom **the kings of the earth have committed fornication**, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her **fornication**;

**1c) 17:3** So he carried me away in the Spirit into the wilderness; and I saw **a woman sitting on a scarlet-colored beast**, full of names of blasphemy, having **seven heads and ten horns**;

**1d) 17:4-5** And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet color, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication. **5** And on her forehead was a name written, **MYSTERY**, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH;

**central axis) 17:6a** And I saw the woman drunk with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Yeshua;

**2d) 17:6b-7a** And when I saw her, I wondered with great wonderment. **7** And the angel said to me, 'Why did you wonder? I will tell you the **mystery** of the woman;

**2c) 17:7b-14** The **beast that carries the woman**, having **seven heads and ten horns**;

**1a) 17:7b** And of the **beast that carries her**, which has the **seven heads and ten horns**;

**1b) 17:8a** **The beast that you saw was, and is not**; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit, and go into perdition;

**central axis) 17:8b** *And they that dwell on the earth shall wonder, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world*;

**2b) 17:8c** When they behold **the beast that was, and is not**, and yet is;

**2a) 17:9-14** The **seven heads and ten horns** of the beast;

**1A) 17:9-10** And here is the mind which has wisdom. The **SEVEN HEADS ARE SEVEN MOUNTAINS**, on which the woman sits. **10** And there are seven kings; five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he comes, he must continue a short space;

**CENTRAL AXIS) 17:11** **AND THE BEAST THAT WAS, AND IS NOT, EVEN HE IS THE EIGHTH, AND IS OF THE SEVEN, AND GOES INTO PERDITION**;

**2A) 17:12-14** The **TEN HORNS ARE TEN KINGS**;

1a) 17:12 And the **ten horns which you saw are ten kings**, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast;  
central axis) 17:13 These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength to the beast;

2a) 17:14 These shall make war with the Lamb, and **the Lamb shall overcome them**, for **He is Lord of lords, and King of kings**; and those who are with Him are called, and chosen, and faithful;'

2b.1) 17:15 And he said to me, '**The waters which you saw, where the harlot sits**, are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and tongues;

2b.2) 17:16-18:8a **The kings of the earth who committed fornication** with her burn her with fire;

1a) 17:16-18:2 The ten horns *shall burn the harlot with fire*;

1A) 17:16 And the **TEN HORNS** which you saw on the beast, these shall hate **THE HARLOT**, and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire; [*i.e.*, *They shall bring about **BABYLON'S FALL***];

1B) 17:17A For God has put in their hearts to **FULFIL HIS WILL**;

CENTRAL AXIS) 17:17B **AND TO AGREE, AND GIVE THEIR KINGDOM TO THE BEAST**;

2B) 17:17C Until the words of God **SHALL BE FULFILLED**;

1A) 17:18-18:2 And **THE WOMAN** which you saw is that great city, which reigns over the **KINGS OF THE EARTH**. 18:1 And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory. 2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, '**BABYLON THE GREAT IS FALLEN, IS FALLEN**, and is become the habitation of demons, and the stronghold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird;

1b.1) 18:3a For *all nations have drunk* of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her;

1b.2) 18:3b And the merchants of the earth *have grown rich through the abundance of her delicacies*;

central axis) 18:4-5 *And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, 'Come out of her, My people, that you do not partake of her sins, and that you do not receive of her plagues. 5 For her sins have reached to heaven, and God has remembered her iniquities*;

2b.1) 18:6 Reward her even as she rewarded you, and double to her double according to her works; *in the cup which she has filled*, fill to her double;

2b.2) 18:7 How much she has glorified herself, and *lived deliciously*, so much torment and sorrow give to her; for she says in her heart, 'I sit a queen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow;'

2a) 18:8a Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine; and *she shall be utterly burned with fire*;

2a) 18:8b For **strong is the Lord God who judges her**;

## 1B) 18:9-19 THE WORLD MOURNS;

- 1a) 18:9a And the kings of the earth, who have committed fornication and **lived deliciously** with her;
- 1b) 18:9b **Shall bewail her**, and **lament for her**;
- 1c) 18:19c When they shall see **the smoke of her burning**;
- 1d) 18:10a **Standing afar off** for the fear of her torment;
- 1e) 18:10b Saying, '**Alas, alas, that great city Babylon**, that mighty city! For **in one hour** your judgment is come;'
- 1f) 18:11a And **the merchants** of the earth shall **weep and mourn** over her;
- 1g) 18:11b For **no man buys their merchandise** any more;
- central axis) 18:12-13 The merchandise of gold, and silver, and precious stones, and of pearls, and fine linen, and purple, and silk, and scarlet, and all citron wood, and all manner vessels of ivory, and all manner vessels of most precious wood, and of brass, and iron, and marble, 13 and cinnamon, and odors, and ointments, and frankincense, and wine, and oil, and fine flour, and wheat, and beasts, and sheep, and horses, and chariots, and slaves, and souls of men;
- 2g) 18:14 And the fruits that your soul lusted after have departed from you, and all things which were dainty and goodly have departed from you, and you shall find them **no more at all**;
- 2f) 18:15 **The merchants** of these things, who were made rich by her, shall stand afar off for the fear of her torment, **weeping and wailing**;
- 2e) 18:16-17a And saying, '**Alas, alas, that great city**, that was clothed in fine linen, and purple, and scarlet, and decked with gold, and precious stones, and pearls! 17 For **in one hour** so great riches is come to nothing;'
- 2d) 18:17b And every shipmaster, and all the company in ships, and sailors, and as many as trade by sea, **stood afar off**;
- 2c) 18:18 And cried when they saw **the smoke of her burning**, saying, 'What city is like this great city!'
- 2b) 18:19a And they cast dust on their heads, and cried, **weeping and wailing**;
- 2a) 18:19b Saying, 'Alas, alas, that great city, in which **were made rich** all that had ships in the sea because of her costliness! For in one hour she is made desolate;'

## 2B) 18:20-19:3a HEAVEN REJOICES;

- 1a) 18:20 **Rejoice** over her, **you heaven**, and you holy apostles and prophets; for **God has avenged you on her**;
- central axis) 18:21-23 And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast it into the sea, saying, 'Just so with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down, and shall be found **no more at all**.'
- 22 And the voice of harpers, and musicians, and of pipers, and trumpet-

ers, shall be heard no more at all in you; and no craftsman, of whatever craft, shall be found any more in you; and the sound of a millstone shall be heard no more at all in you; 23 and the light of a lamp shall shine no more at all in you; and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in you; for your merchants were the great men of the earth; for by your sorceries [*i.e., pharmakeia*] were all nations deceived;

**2a) 18:24-19:3a Heaven rejoices**, for **God has avenged** the blood of His servants;

*1a.1) 18:24* And in her was found *the blood of prophets, and of saints*, and of all that were slain on the earth;

*1a.2) 19:1a* And after these things I heard a great voice of many people in heaven, saying, '*Alleluia!*'

*1b) 19:1b-2a* Salvation, and glory, and honor, and power, be to the Lord our God; 2 for true and righteous are *His judgments*;

*2b) 19:2b* For *He has judged the great harlot*;

*2a.1) 19:2c* Who corrupted the earth with her fornication, and *has avenged the blood of His servants at her hand*;

*2a.2) 19:3a* And again they said, '*Alleluia!*'

**2A) 19:3B** And **HER SMOKE ROSE UP FOR EVER AND EVER.**
