Rev 19:11-22:6a, Messiah's Second Advent

1A.1) 19:11A And I saw **HEAVEN OPENED**;

1A.2) 19:11B And behold a white horse; and He who sat on him was called **FAITHFUL AND TRUE**;

1B) 19:11C And **IN RIGHTEOUSNESS HE JUDGES**;

1C) 19:11D-21 The return of the King completes **BABYLON'S DEFEAT**;

1a) 19:11d-16a In righteousness **He makes war**;

1a) 19:11d-12 And makes war. **12** His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns; and He had *a name written*, that no man knew, but He Himself;

1b) 19:13a And He was clothed with a garment *dipped in blood*;

1c) 19:13b And His name is called *The Word of God*;

central axis) 19:14 And the armies which were in heaven followed Him on white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean;

2c) 19:15a And *out of His mouth went a sharp sword*, that with it He should strike the nations; and He shall rule them with a rod of iron;

2b) 19:15b And He *treads the winepress* of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God;

2a) 19:16a And He has on His garment and on His thigh *a name written*;
central axis) 19:16b KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS;

2a) 19:17-21 The war and its outcome;

1a) 19:17-18 And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to *all the winged creatures* that fly in the midst of heaven, 'Come and gather yourselves together to the supper of the great God; **18** *that you may eat the flesh* of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of those that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and bond, both small and great;'

1b) 19:19 And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, *gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse*, and against His army;

1c) 19:20a And *the beast* was taken, *and with him the false prophet* that wrought miracles before him;

central axis) 19:20b With which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast, and those who worshiped his image;

2c) 19:20c *These both* were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone;

2b) 19:21a And *the remnant were slain with the sword of Him who sat on the horse*, whose sword proceeded out of His mouth;

2a) 19:21b And *all the winged creatures were filled with their flesh*;

CENTRAL AXIS) 20:1-7 THE MILLENNIUM OF REST;

1a) 20:1-3 And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. **2** And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, **which is the Devil, and Satan**, and **bound him a thousand years**, **3** and cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and **after that he must be loosed** a little season;

1b) 20:4 And I saw thrones, and those who sat on them, and judgment was given to them; and I saw the souls of those who were beheaded for the witness of Yeshua, and for the word of God, and who had not worshiped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark on their foreheads, nor in their hands; and they lived and **reigned with Messiah a thousand years**;

1c) 20:5a But **the rest of the dead did not live again** until the thousand years were finished;

central axis) 20:5b-6a This is the first resurrection. **6** Blessed and holy is he that has a part in the first resurrection;

2c) 20:6b On such **the second death** has no power;

2b) 20:6c But they shall be priests of God and of Messiah, and shall **reign with Him a thousand years**;

2a) 20:7 And when **the thousand years** are expired, **Satan shall be loosed** out of his prison;

2C) 20:8-10 The final rebellion of God and Magog; **SATAN'S FINAL DEFEAT**;

1a) 20:8 And shall go out **to deceive the nations** which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle; the number of whom is as the sand of the sea;

central axis) 20:9 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and encircled the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city; and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them;

2a) 20:10 And **the devil that deceived them** was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever;

2B) 20:11-15 The great white throne of **JUDGMENT**;

1a) 20:11a And I saw a great white throne, and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. **12**

And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened; and another book was opened, which is **the book of life**;

1b) 20:11b And **the dead were judged** out of those things which were written in the books, **according to their works**;

central axis) 20:13a And the sea gave up the dead which was in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them;

2b) 20:13b And **they were judged** every man **according to their works**;

2a) 20:14-15 The fate of those not found written in **the book of life**;

1a) 20:14 And death and hell were **cast into the lake of fire**. This is the second death;

central axis) 20:15a And **whoever was not found written in the book of life**;

2a) 20:15b Was **cast into the lake of fire**;

2A.1) 21:1-22:6a The **NEW HEAVENS** and the new earth;

1a.1) 21:-5a The **new Jerusalem**, adorned as **a bride for her husband**;

1a) 21:1a And I saw a **new heaven** and a **new earth**;

1b) 21:1b-2 For **the first heaven and the first earth were passed away**; and there was no more sea. **2** And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband;

1c) 21:3a And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, 'Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and **He will dwell with them**;

central axis) 21:3b And **they shall be His people**;

2c) 21:3c And **God Himself shall be with them**, and be their God;

2b) 21:4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain; for **the former things are passed away**;

2a) 21:5a And He who sat on the throne said, 'Behold, I make **all things new**;

1a.2) 21:5b And He said to me, 'Write; for these words are **true and faithful**;

1b) 21:6 And He said to me, 'It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give to him that is thirsty of the fountain of the water of life freely; [*i.e.*, **What will become of those who have received God**];

central axis) 21:7 He that **overcomes shall inherit all things**; and I will be his God, and he shall be My son;

2b) 21:8 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death; [*i.e.*, **What will become of those who have rejected God**];

2a.1) 21:9-22:5 The **bride**, the **Lamb's wife**, which is **new Jerusalem**;

1a) 21:9-23 The New Jerusalem / her clear light, with **no need of the sun**, for **the Lamb is its light**;

1A.1) 21:9-11A New Jerusalem, descending from heaven, having **THE GLORY OF GOD**;

1a) 21:9 And there came to me one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, 'Come here; **I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife**;'

central axis) **21:10a** And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain;

2a) 21:10b-11a And **he showed me** that great city, **the holy Jerusalem**, descending out of heaven from God, **it** having the glory of God;

1A.2) 21:11B And **HER LIGHT** was like a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal;

1B) 21:12-13 And had a wall great and high, and had **TWELVE GATES**, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written on them, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel; **13** on the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates;

1C.1) 21:14A And **THE WALL** of the city;

1C.2) 21:14B Had twelve **FOUNDATIONS**, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb;

CENTRAL AXIS) 21:15-17 AND HE THAT TALKED WITH ME HAD A GOLDEN REED TO MEASURE THE CITY, AND THE ITS GATES, AND ITS WALL. **16** AND THE CITY LAY FOURSQUARE, THE LENGTH IS AS LARGE AS THE BREADTH; AND HE MEASURED THE CITY WITH THE REED, TWELVE THOUSAND FURLONGS. THE LENGTH AND THE BREADTH AND THE HEIGHT OF IT ARE EQUAL. **17** AND HE MEASURED ITS WALL, A HUNDRED AND FORTY-FOUR CUBITS, ACCORDING TO THE MEASURE OF A MAN, THAT IS, OF THE ANGEL;

2C.1) 21:18 And the building of **THE WALL** was of jasper; and the city was pure gold, like clear glass;

2C.2) 21:19-20 And the **FOUNDATIONS** of the wall of the city were garnished with all manner of precious stones. The first foundation was jasper; the second, sapphire; the third, a chalcedony; the fourth, an emerald; **20** the fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolite; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, a topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst;

2B) 21:21-22 And the **TWELVE GATES** were twelve pearls; every gate was of one pearl; and the street of the city was pure gold, as transparent glass. **22** And I saw no temple in it; for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple;

2A.1) 21:23A And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it, for **THE GLORY OF GOD** enlightened it;

2A.2) 21:23B And the Lamb is **ITS LIGHT**;

1b) 21:24-27a Its gates shall not be shut; *there shall be no night there*;

1A) 21:24A And the nations of those who are saved shall walk in the light of it;

1B) 21:24B And the kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it;

CENTRAL AXIS) 21:25 AND ITS GATES SHALL NOT BE SHUT AT ALL BY DAY, FOR
THERE SHALL BE NO NIGHT THERE;

2B) 21:26 And they shall bring the glory and honor of the nations into it;

2A) 21:27A And there shall in no way enter into it any thing that defiles, neither what-
ever works abomination, or makes a lie;

1c) 21:27b But they [*whose names*] are written in the Lamb's book of life;

1d) 22:1 And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceed-
ing out of *the throne of God and of the Lamb*;

central axis) 22:2 *In the midst of its street, and on either side of the riv-
er, there was the tree of life, which bore twelve kinds of fruits, and
yielded her fruit every month; and the leaves of the tree were for the
healing of the nations*;

2d) 22:3 And there shall be no more curse, but *the throne of God and of the
Lamb* shall be in it; and His servants shall serve Him;

2c) 22:4 And they shall see His face; and *His name* shall be in their foreheads;

2b) 22:5a And *there shall be no night there*;

2a) 22:5b And *they need no* lamp, neither the *light of the sun*; for *the Lord
God gives them light*; and they shall reign for ever and ever;

2a.2) 22:6 And he said to me, 'These sayings are **faithful and true**;'

1A.2) 22:6A And he said to me, 'These sayings are **FAITHFUL AND TRUE**.'
