



Revelation 12:1-15:4, The Second Interval

1A) 12:1-13:18 BABYLON'S WAR AGAINST GOD, when it seems **VICTORIOUS**;

1a) 12:1-17 War in heaven;

1a.1) 12:1-5 The *woman gave birth to a male Child* who was to rule the nations with a rod of iron;

1A) 12:1-2 And there appeared a great sign in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars; **2** and **SHE BEING WITH CHILD** cried, laboring in birth, and pained to be delivered;

1B) 12:3A And there appeared another sign in heaven; and behold, a **GREAT RED DRAGON**;

1C) 12:3B Having **SEVEN HEADS**;

CENTRAL AXIS) 12:3C AND TEN HORNS;

2C) 12:3D-4A And **SEVEN CROWNS ON HIS HEADS**. **4** And his tail drew down the third part of the stars of heaven, and cast them to the earth;

2B) 12:4B And the **DRAGON**;

2A) 12:4C-5 Stood before the **WOMAN WHO WAS READY TO GIVE BIRTH**, to devour her Child / her Child caught up to God;

1a) 12:4c Stood before the woman who was ready to be delivered, **in order to devour her Child** as soon as it was born;

central axis) 12:5a And she brought forth a male Child, who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron;

2a) 12:5b And **her Child was caught up to God**, and to His throne;

1a.2) 12:6 And *the woman fled into the wilderness*, where she has a place prepared by God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and sixty days;

1b) 12:7-9 The great dragon was *cast out into the earth*;

1A) 12:7-8 And there was war in heaven; Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and **THE DRAGON FOUGHT AND HIS ANGELS**, **8** and did not prevail; neither was a place found for them any more in heaven;

1B) 12:9A And **THE GREAT DRAGON WAS CAST OUT**, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan;

CENTRAL AXIS) 12:9B WHICH DECEIVES THE WHOLE WORLD;

2B) 12:9C HE WAS CAST OUT into the earth;

2A) 12:9D And **HIS ANGELS** were cast out with him;

1c) 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, 'Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Messiah; for *the accuser of our brethren is cast down*, who accused them before our God day and night;

central axis) 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives to the death;

2c) 12:12 Therefore rejoice, you heavens, and you who dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! For *the devil is come down to you*, having great wrath, because he knows that he has but a short time;'

2b) 12:13a And when the dragon saw that *he was cast to the earth*;

2a.1) 12:13b He persecuted the *woman who brought forth the male Child*;

2a.2) 12:14-17 But *she fled into the wilderness* to her place, for a time, times, and half a time;

1A) 12:14 And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly to the wilderness, to her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, **FROM THE FACE OF THE SERPENT**;

1B) 12:15A And **THE SERPENT CAST OUT OF HIS MOUTH** water as a flood after the woman;

1C) 12:15B That he might cause her to be carried away **BY THE FLOOD**;

CENTRAL AXIS) 12:16A AND THE EARTH HELPED THE WOMAN;

2C) 12:16B And the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed up **THE FLOOD**;

2B) 12:16C Which **THE DRAGON CAST OUT OF HIS MOUTH**;

2A) 12:17 And **THE DRAGON WAS VERY ANGRY WITH THE WOMAN**, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, who keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Yeshua Messiah;

2a) 13:1-18 War on earth; [*i.e., The height of the dragon's power during the Middle Ages*];

1a) 13:1-8 The *beast of the sea* / its authority and worship;

1A) 13:1-4B The beast of the sea / its description, **AUTHORITY, AND WORSHIP**;

1a) 13:1-2a And I stood on the sand of the sea, and saw **a beast rise up out of the sea**, having seven heads and ten horns, and on his horns ten crowns, and on his heads the name of blasphemy. **2** And the beast which I saw was like a leopard, and his feet were as the feet of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion;

1b) 13:2b And the **dragon gave him his power**, and his throne, and great authority;

central axis) 13:3 And I saw **one of his heads as it were wounded to death**; and his deadly wound was healed; and all the world wondered after the beast;

2b) 13:4a And they worshiped the **dragon who had given power** to the beast;

2a) 13:4b And they worshiped **the beast**, saying, 'Who is like the beast?'

1B) 13:4C Who is able **TO MAKE WAR** with him?'

1C) 13:5A And there was given to him **A MOUTH SPEAKING** great things and **BLASPHEMIES**;

central axis) 13:5b And power was given to him to make war forty-two months;

2C) 13:6 And he opened **HIS MOUTH IN BLASPHEMY** against God, to blaspheme His name, and His tabernacle, and those who dwell in heaven;

2B) 13:7A And it was given to him **TO MAKE WAR** with the saints, and to overcome them;

2a) 13:7b-8 And **POWER WAS GIVEN HIM** over all tribes, and tongues, and nations. **8** And all who dwell on the earth **SHALL WORSHIP HIM**, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world;

central axis) 13:9-10a *If any man has an ear, let him hear. 10 He who leads into captivity shall go into captivity; he who kills with the sword must be killed with the sword;*

2a) 13:10b-18 The **beast of the land** / its authority and worship;

1A) 13:10B **HERE IS THE PATIENCE AND THE FAITH OF THE SAINTS;**

1B) 13:11-12A And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spoke as a dragon. **12** And he exercised all the power of the first beast before him; and **CAUSED THE EARTH** and those who dwell in it **TO WORSHIP** the first beast;

1C) 13:12B Whose **DEADLY WOUND** was healed;

1D) 13:13 And he does **GREAT WONDERS**, so that he makes fire come down from heaven on the earth in the sight of men;

CENTRAL AXIS) 13:14A **AND DECEIVES THOSE WHO DWELL ON THE EARTH;**

2D) 13:14B By the means of those **MIRACLES** which he had power to do in the sight of the beast;

2C) 13:14C Saying to those who dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which was **WOUNDED BY A SWORD**, and lived;

2B) 13:15 And he had power to give life to the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and **CAUSE AS MANY AS WOULD NOT WORSHIP** the image of the beast to be killed;

2A) 13:16-18 And he caused all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads, **17** that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. **18** **HERE IS WISDOM**. Let him who has understanding count the number of the beast, for it is the number of a man; and his number is six hundred sixty-six;

CENTRAL AXIS) 14:1-5 The **TRUE LAMB** and the **TRUE WORSHIPERS;**

1a) 14:1 And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on Mount Zion, and with Him **a hundred and forty-four thousand**, having His Father's name written in their foreheads;

1b) 14:2-3a And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder; and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps; **3** and they sang as it were **a new song**;

central axis) 14:3b Before the throne, and before the four beings, and the elders;

2b) 14:3c And no man could learn **that song**;

2a) 14:3d-5 The **hundred and forty-four thousand** who were redeemed from the earth;

1a.1) 14:3e But the hundred and forty-four thousand, *who were redeemed* from the earth;

1a.2) 14:4a *These are they who were not defiled* with women; for they are virgins;

central axis) 14:4b *These are they who follow the Lamb wherever He goes*;

2a.1) 14:4c *These were redeemed* from among men, being the firstfruits to God and to the Lamb;

2a.2) 14:5 And in their mouth was found no guile, for *they are without fault* before the throne of God;

2A) 14:6-15:4 GOD'S WAR AGAINST BABYLON, when its **DEFEAT** is **PROPHECIED**;

1a) 14:6-7 And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting Gospel to preach to them who dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and tribe, and tongue, and people, **7** saying with a loud voice, '**Fear God, and give glory to Him**; for **the hour of His judgment is come**, and **worship Him** who made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters;'

1b.1) 14:8 And there followed another angel, saying, 'Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she made all nations **drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication**;

1b.2) 14:9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, 'If any man **worships the beast and his image**, and **receives his mark** in his forehead, or in his hand;

1b.1 repeated) 14:10-11a The same **shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God**, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of His indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb; **11** and the smoke of their torment ascends up for ever and ever; and they have no rest day nor night;

1b.2 repeated) 14:11b Who **worships the beast and his image**, and whoever **receives the mark of his name**;

1b.3) 14:12-13 Here is the patience of the saints; here are those who keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Yeshua.' **13** And I heard a voice from heaven

saying to me, 'Write, "Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from here on;'
'Yes,' says the Spirit, 'that they may rest from their labors; and their works follow
them;' *[i.e., Those who die in the Lord, and rest]*;

1c) 14:14-16 The Son of Man **reaps the harvest of the earth;**

1a) 14:14 And I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and **on the cloud one sat like
the Son of man**, having on His head a golden crown, and in His hand a sharp
sickle;

central axis) 14:15 **And another angel came out of the temple, crying with
a loud voice to Him who sat on the cloud, 'Thrust in Your sickle, and
reap; for the time is come for You to reap; for the harvest of the earth
is ripe;'**

2a) 14:16 And **He who sat on the cloud** thrust in His sickle on the earth; and the
earth was reaped;

2c) 14:17-19a An angel **reaps the grapes of wrath;**

1a) 14:17 And **another angel** came out of the temple which is in heaven, **he also
having a sharp sickle;**

central axis) 14:18 **And another angel came out from the altar, which had
power over fire, and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp
sickle, saying, 'Thrust in your sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of
the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe;'**

2a) 14:19a And **the angel thrust in his sickle** to the earth, and gathered the vine
of the earth;

2b.1) 14:19b-15:1 The great **winepress of the wrath of God;**

1a) 14:19b-20 And cast it into the great winepress of **the wrath of God**. **20** And
the winepress was trodden outside the city, and blood came out of the wine-
press, even to the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand six hundred fur-
longs;

central axis) 15:1a **And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous:
seven angels having the seven last plagues;**

2a) 15:1b For in them **the wrath of God** is filled up;

2b.2) 15:2 Those who had **gotten victory over the beast, and over his image,
mark, and number;**

1a) 14:15a And I saw as it were a **sea of glass** mingled with fire;

central axis) 14:15b **And those who had gotten the victory over the beast,
and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his
name;**

2a) 14:15c Stand on the **sea of glass**, having the harps of God;

2b.3) 15:3a And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the
Lamb, saying; *[i.e., Those who had gotten victory over the beast, who have died in the
Lord, and are at rest]*;

2a) 15:3b-4 'Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are Your ways, You King of saints. **4 Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name?** For You alone are holy; for **all nations shall come and worship** before You; **for Your judgments are made manifest.**'
