# Lev 26:3-27:34 Bechukotai Expanded Chiasm

## 1A) 26:3-9B IF YOU WALK IN MY STATUTES, AND KEEP



- MY COMMANDMENTS, AND DO THEM, these blessings will come upon you;
  - **1a.1) 26:3** If you walk in My statutes, and keep My commandments, and do them; *[i.e., How we show* **respect for YHVH**];
  - 1a.2) 26:4-5a Then I will give your rains in their season, and the land shall yield her produce, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit. 5 And your threshing shall reach to the vintage, and the vintage shall reach to the sowing time; and you shall eat your bread until you have enough;
  - 1b) 26:5b And dwell in your land safely;
  - central axis) 26:6a And I will give peace in the land, and you shall lie down, and none shall make you afraid;
  - 2b) 26:6b-8 And I will cause evil beasts to cease out of the land, neither shall the sword go through your land. 7 And you shall chase your enemies, and they shall fall before you by the sword. 8 And five of you shall chase a hundred, and a hundred of you shall chase ten thousand; and your enemies shall fall before you by the sword;
  - 2a.1) 26:9a And I will have respect for you;
  - 2a.2) 26:9b And make you fruitful, and multiply you;

### 1B) 26:9C-13 And MY SOUL SHALL NOT ABHOR YOU; {p}

- 1a) 26:9c-10 And will establish My covenant with you. 10 And you shall eat old store long kept, and you shall bring forth the old from before the new;
- **1b) 26:11a** And I will set My tabernacle **among you**;

### central axis) 26:11b And My soul shall not abhor you;

- 2b) 26:12a And I will walk among you;
- 2a) 26:12b-13 And I will be your God, and you shall be My people; [*i.e.*, The covenant which YHVH established (Exo 19:5-6)];

1a) 26:12b And will be your God;

central axis) 26:12c And you shall be My people;

2a) 26:13 I am YHVH your God, who brought you forth out of the land of Egypt, that you should not be their bondmen; and I have broken the bars of your yoke, and made you go upright; {p}

- 1C) 26:14-15 If you shall REJECT MY STATUTES, and IF YOUR SOUL ABHORS MY ORDINANCES;
  - la) 26:14a But if you will not pay heed unto Me;
  - 1b) 26:14b And will not do all these commandments;
  - central axis) 26:15a And if you shall reject My statutes, and if your soul abhors My ordinances;

# 2b) 26:15b So that you will not do all My commandments;2a) 26:15c But break My covenant;

- 1D) 26:16-29 I will chastise you SEVEN TIMES MORE for your sins; {s ...}
  - 1a.1) 26:16-17 You shall be stricken before your enemies;
    - *Ia) 26:16a* I also will do this to you: *I will appoint terror over you*, even consumption and fever, that shall make your eyes to fail, and your soul to languish;
    - 1b) 26:16b And you shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it;

#### central axis) 26:17a And I will set My face against you;

*2b) 26:17b* And you shall be *stricken before your enemies*; they that hate you shall rule over you;

2a) 26:17c And you shall flee when no one pursues you;

- 1a.2) 26:18 And if you will not, because of these things, yet pay heed to Me, then I will chastise you seven times more for your sins;
- 1b) 26:19-20 And I will break the pride of your power; and I will make your heaven as iron, and your earth as brass. 20 And your strength shall be spent in vain; for your land shall not yield her produce, neither shall the trees of the land yield their fruit;
- 1c) 26:21 And if you walk contrary unto Me, and will not pay heed to Me; I will bring seven times more plagues upon you according to your sins;
- central axis) 26:22 And I will send the beast of the field among you, which shall rob you of your children, and destroy your cattle, and make you few in number; and your ways shall become desolate;
- 2c) 26:23-24 And if in spite of these things you will not be corrected by Me, but will walk contrary to Me; 24 then will I also walk contrary to you; and I will strike you, even I, seven times for your sins;
- **2b) 26:25a** And **I will bring a sword upon you**, that shall execute the vengeance of the covenant; and you shall be gathered together within your cities; and **I will send the pestilence** among you;

2a.1) 26:25b And you shall be delivered into the hand of the enemy;

- 2a.2) 26:26-29 If you will not pay heed to Me, for all this, I will chastise you seven times for your sins;
  - 1a) 26:26 When I break your staff of bread, ten women shall bake your bread in one oven, and they shall deliver your bread again by weight; and you shall eat, and not be satisfied; {s}
  - central axis) 26:27-28 And if you will not, for all this, pay heed to Me, but walk contrary to Me, 28 then I will walk contrary

to you in fury; and I also will chastise you seven times for your sins;

- 2a) 26:29 And you shall eat the flesh of your sons, and the flesh of your daughters shall you eat;
- **1E) 26:30A** And I will **DESTROY YOUR HIGH PLACES**, and cut down your sun pillars, and cast your carcasses upon the carcasses of your idols;

#### CENTRAL AXIS) 26:30B AND MY SOUL SHALL ABHOR YOU;

#### 2E) 26:31-33 I will BRING THE LAND INTO DESOLATION;

- 1a) 26:31 And I will make your cities a waste, and will bring your sanctuaries to desolation, and I will not smell the savor of your sweet aromas;
- **1b) 26:32** And I will **bring the land into desolation**; and your enemies that dwell in it shall be astonished at it;
- central axis) 26:33a And you I will scatter among the nations;
- **2b) 26:33b** And I will draw out the sword after you; and your **land shall be a desolation**;
- 2a) 26:33c And your cities shall be a waste;
- 2D) 26:34-43A Then shall the land be PAID HER SABBATHS, as long as it lies desolate;
  - 1a) 26:34-35 The land shall be paid her Sabbaths;
    - *la) 26:34a* Then shall the land be *paid her Sabbaths*;
    - *1b) 26:34b As long as it lies desolate*, and you are in your enemies' land;

# *central axis) 26:34c Even then shall the land rest, and repay her Sabbaths;*

- 2b) 26:35a As long as it lies desolate it shall have rest;
- *2a) 26:35b* Even the rest which it did not have in your *Sabbaths*, when you dwelt upon it;
- 1b) 26:36-38 Israel in the lands of her enemies;
  - 1a) 26:36a And as for them that are left of you, I will send a faintness into their heart in the lands of their enemies; and the sound of a driven leaf shall chase them;
  - 1b) 26:36b And they shall flee;
  - central axis) 26:36c-37a As one flees from the sword; and they shall fall when none pursues. 37 And they shall stumble one upon another, as it were before the sword, when none pursues;
  - *2b) 26:37b* And *you shall have no power to stand* before your enemies;

*2a) 26:38* And you shall perish among the nations, and the *land of your enemies* shall eat you up;

- 1c) 26:39-40a And they that are left of you shall pine away in their iniquity in your enemies' lands; and also in the iniquities of their fathers shall they pine away with them. 40 And they shall confess their iniquity, and the iniquity of their fathers;
- central axis) 26:40b-41a In their treachery which they committed against Me, and also that they have walked contrary to Me. 41 I also will walk contrary to them, and bring them into the land of their enemies;
- **2c) 26:41b** If then perhaps **their uncircumcised heart becomes humbled**, and they then are paid the punishment of their iniquity;
- **2b) 26:42** Then will I remember My covenant with Jacob, and also My covenant with Isaac, and also My covenant with Abraham I will remember; and I will remember the land;
- 2a) 26:43a For the land shall lie forsaken without them, and shall be paid her Sabbaths, while she lies desolate without them; and they shall be paid the punishment of their iniquity;
- 2C) 26:43B Because, even because they REJECTED MY ORDINANCES, and THEIR SOUL ABHORRED MY STATUTES;
- 2B) 26:44-45 And yet for all that, when they are in the land of their enemies, I will not reject them, NEITHER WILL I ABHOR THEM, to destroy them utterly, and to break My covenant with them; for I am YHVH their God. 45 But I will for their sakes remember the covenant of their ancestors, whom I brought forth out of the land of Egypt in the sight of the nations, that I might be their God: I am YHVH;""

2A) 26:46-27:34 THESE ARE THE STATUTES AND ORDINANCES AND LAWS, which YHVH made between Him and the children of Israel in Mount Sinai by the hand of Moses. ... THESE ARE THE COMMANDMENTS, which YHVH commanded Moses for the children of Israel in Mount Sinai; {p+s+p}

- 1a) 26:46 These are the statutes and ordinances and laws, which YHVH made between Him and the children of Israel in Mount Sinai by the hand of Moses; {p}
  1b) 27:1-24 Valuation for redemption;
  - 1a.1) 27:1-8 And YHVH spoke to Moses, saying, 2 'Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them, "When a man shall clearly utter a vow of persons to YHVH, according to your valuation, 3 then your valuation shall be for the male from twenty years old even to sixty years old, even your valuation shall be fifty shekels of silver, *after the shekel of the sanctuary*. 4 And if it is a female, then your valuation shall be thirty shekels. 5 And if it is from five years old even to twenty years old, then your valuation shall be for the

male twenty shekels, and for the female ten shekels. 6 And if it is from a month old even to five years old, then your valuation shall be for the male five shekels of silver, and for the female your valuation shall be three shekels of silver. 7 And if it is from sixty years old and upward: if it is a male, then your valuation shall be fifteen shekels, and for the female ten shekels. 8 But if he is too poor for your valuation, then he shall be set before the priest, and the priest shall value him; according to his means that vowed shall the priest value him; {s}

- 1a.2) 27:9-10 And if it is a beast, by which men bring an offering to YHVH, all that any man gives of such to YHVH shall be holy. 10 He shall not alter it, nor change it, a good for a bad, or a bad for a good; and if he shall at all change beast for beast, then both it and that for which it is changed shall be holy;
- 1a.3) 27:11-13 And if it is any unclean beast, of which they may not bring an offering to YHVH, then he shall set the beast before the priest. 12 And the priest shall value it, whether it is good or bad; as the priest values it, so shall it be. 13 But if he will indeed redeem it, then he shall add the fifth part of it to your valuation;
- 1b) 27:14-18 When a man shall sanctify his house or his field;
  - 1A) 27:14A And WHEN A MAN SHALL SANCTIFY HIS HOUSE to be holy to YHVH;
  - **1B) 27:14**B Then THE PRIEST SHALL VALUE IT, whether it is good or bad; as the priest shall value it, so shall it stand;
  - CENTRAL AXIS) 27:15A AND IF HE THAT SANCTIFIED IT WILL REDEEM HIS HOUSE;
  - **2B) 27:15B** Then he shall add the fifth part of the money of your **VALUATION** to it, and it shall be his;
  - 2A) 27:16-18 And IF A MAN SHALL SANCTIFY TO YHVH PART OF THE FIELD OF HIS POSSESSION, then your valuation shall be according to its sowing; the sowing of a homer of barley shall be valued at fifty shekels of silver. 17 If he sanctify his field from the year of Jubilee, according to your valuation it shall stand. 18 But if he sanctify his field after the Jubilee, then the priest shall reckon to him the money according to the years that remain to the year of Jubilee, and an abatement shall be made from your valuation;

#### *Ic) 27:19a* And if he that sanctified the field *will indeed redeem* it; *central axis) 27:19b Then he shall add the fifth part of the money of your valuation to it, and it shall be assured to him*;

*2c) 27:20-21* And if he *will not redeem* the field, or if he has sold the field to another man, it shall not be redeemed any more. **21** But the field, when it goes out in the Jubilee, shall be holy to YHVH, as a field devoted; its possession shall be the priest's;

2b) 27:22-24 If he sanctify to YHVH a field which he has bought;

- 1A) 27:22 And if he sanctify to YHVH A FIELD WHICH HE HAS BOUGHT, which is not of THE FIELD OF HIS POSSESSION;
- **1B) 27:23A** Then the priest shall reckon to him the worth of your valuation to THE YEAR OF JUBILEE;
- CENTRAL AXIS) 27:23B AND HE SHALL GIVE YOUR VALUATION IN THAT DAY, AS A HOLY THING TO YHVH;
- 2B) 27:24A In THE YEAR OF JUBILEE the field shall return to him;
- 2A) 27:24B Of whom IT WAS BOUGHT, even to him to whom THE POSSESSION OF THE LAND belongs;
- 2a.1) 27:25 And all your valuations shall be according to the shekel of the sanctuary; twenty gerahs shall be the shekel;
- 2a.2) 27:26 However the firstborn among beasts, which is born as a firstborn to YHVH, no man shall sanctify it; whether it be ox or sheep, it is YHVH's;
- *2a.3) 27:27* And *if it is of an unclean beast*, then he shall ransom it according to your valuation; and shall add to it the fifth part of it; or if it is not redeemed, then it shall be sold according to your valuation;

2b) 27:28-33 Devoted things shall not be redeemed;

- 1a) 27:28a Notwithstanding, no devoted thing, that a man may devote to YHVH of all that he has, whether of man or beast, or of the field of his possession, shall be sold or *redeemed*;
- 1b) 27:28b Every devoted thing is most holy to YHVH;
- *Ic) 27:29a* None devoted, that may be devoted of men, shall be *ransomed*;

#### central axis) 27:29b He shall surely be put to death;

2c) 27:30-31 And all the tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land, or of the fruit of the tree, is YHVH's; it is holy to YHVH. 31 And *if a man will* redeem any of his tithe, he shall add to it the fifth part of it;

2b) 27:32-33c The tithe of the herd or flock shall be holy to YHVH;

- 1A) 27:32 And all the tithe of the herd or the flock, whatsoever passes under the rod, the tenth SHALL BE HOLY TO YHVH;
- 1B) 27:33A He shall not inquire whether it be good or bad, NEITHER SHALL HE CHANGE IT;

**2B) 27:33B** And IF HE CHANGE IT at all;

2A) 27:83C Then both it and that for which it is changed SHALL BE HOLY;

*2a) 27:33d* It shall not be *redeemed*;""

**2a) 27:34 These are the commandments**, which YHVH commanded Moses for the children of Israel in Mount Sinai. {p}
