2A) 10:11-36 ISRAEL SET FORWARD as the ark sought a resting place; {sx2+p}

1a) 10:11-12 And it came to pass in the second year, in the second month, on the twentieth day of the month, that the cloud was taken up from over the tabernacle of the testimony. 12 And the children of Israel set forward by their

stages out of the wilderness of Sinai; and the cloud abode in the wilderness of Paran;

- **1b) 10:13-28 They set forward; {s}**
- 1c) 10:29a And Moses said to Hobab, the son of Reuel the Midianite, Moses' fatherin-law, "We are journeying to the place of which YHVH said, 'I will give it you;' come with us, and we will do you good;
- 1d) 10:29b For YHVH has spoken good concerning Israel;

 - central axis) 10:33c And the ark of the covenant of YHVH went before them;
 - 2b) 10:33d Three days' journey, to seek out a resting place for them;
 - 2a) 10:34 And the cloud of YHVH was over them by day, when they set forward from the camp; {s}
- 2a) 10:35-36 And it came to pass, when the ark set forward, that Moses said, "Rise up, O YHVH, and let Your enemies be scattered; and let them that hate You flee before You." 36 And when it rested, he said, "Return, O YHVH, to the ten thousands of the families of Israel." {p}
