- 1b) 4:34a And Moses and Aaron and the princes of the congregation numbered:
- 1c) 4:34b-45 The sons of the Kohathites by their families, and by their fathers' houses, 35 from thirty years old and upward even to fifty years old, every one that entered on the service, for service in the tent of meeting. 36 And those that were numbered of them by their families were two thousand seven hundred and fifty. 37 These are they that were numbered of the families of the Kohathites, of all that did serve in the tent of meeting, whom Moses and Aaron numbered according to the commandment of YHVH by the hand of Moses. {s} 38 And those that were numbered of the sons of Gershon, by their families, and by their fathers' houses, 39 from thirty years old and upward even to fifty years old, every one that entered on the service, for service in the tent of meeting, 40 even those

- 2c) 4:46a All those that were numbered of the Levites;
- **2b) 4:46b** Whom **Moses and Aaron and the princes of Israel numbered**, by their families, and by their fathers' houses, **47** from thirty years old and upward even to fifty years old, every one that entered in to do the work of service, and the work of bearing burdens in the tent of meeting, **48** even those that were numbered of them, were eight thousand five hundred and eighty;
- 2a) 4:49 According to the commandment of YHVH they were appointed by the hand of Moses, every one to his service, and to his burden; they were also numbered, as YHVH commanded Moses; {p}
- **1B) 5:1-4 SEPARATE** the lepers, unclean, and defiled from the midst of the camp where YHVH dwells; {p}
 - 1a) 5:1 And YHVH spoke to Moses, saying;
 - 1b) 5:2-3a The command to put lepers, defiled, and unclean outside the camp;

 - 2A) 5:3B You shall put out, OUTSIDE THE CAMP YOU SHALL PUT THEM;
 - central axis) 5:3 That they defile not their camp, in the midst of which I dwell;'
 - 2b) 5:4a And the children of Israel did so, and put them outside the camp;
 - 2a) 5:4b As YHVH spoke to Moses, so the children of Israel did; {p}
 - 1C) 5:5-7A And YHVH spoke to Moses, saying: 6 "Speak to the children of Israel, 'When a man or woman shall commit any sin that men commit, to commit a trespass against YHVH, and that soul is guilty; 7 then THEY SHALL CONFESS THEIR SIN which they have done; [i.e., Anyone who commits sin does so in UN-FAITHFULNESS against YHVH];

1D) 5:7B-8A And he shall make restitution for his guilt in full, and add to it its fifth part, and give it to him against whom he has been guilty. 8 But if the man have no kinsman redeemer to whom restitution may be made for the guilt, the restitution for guilt which is made shall be YHVH's, even FOR THE PRIEST;

CENTRAL AXIS) 5:8B BESIDES THE RAM OF THE ATONEMENT, WITH WHICH ATONEMENT SHALL BE MADE FOR HIM;

- 2D) 5:9-10 And every heave offering of all the holy things of the children of Israel, which they present to the priest, shall be his. 10 And every man's hallowed things shall be his; WHATEVER ANY MAN SHALL GIVE THE PRIEST, IT SHALL BE HIS; {p}
- 2C) 5:11-31 The law of a jealous husband /UNFAITHFUL wife who does not CONFESS HER SIN; {p}
 - **1a.1)** 5:11-13 And YHVH spoke to Moses, saying, 12 "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them, 'If any man's wife goes aside, and act unfaithfully against him, 13 and a man lie with her carnally, and it is hidden from the eyes of her husband, she being defiled secretly, and there are no witnesses against her, neither has she been taken in the act;
 - 1a.2) 5:14 And the spirit of jealousy comes upon him, and he becomes jealous of his wife, and she is defiled; or if the spirit of jealousy comes upon him, and he becomes jealous of his wife, and she is not defiled;
 - **1a.3**) 5:15-16 Then shall the man bring his wife to the priest, and shall bring her offering for her, the tenth part of an ephah of barley meal; he shall pour no oil on it, nor put frankincense on it; for it is a grain offering of jealousy, a grain offering of memorial, of bringing iniquity to remembrance. **16** And the priest shall bring her near, and **set her before YHVH**;
 - 1b) 5:17-18 The water of bitterness that brings the curse;
 - **1A) 5:17** And the priest shall take holy water in an earthen vessel; and of the dust that is on the floor of the tabernacle the priest shall take, and put it into **THE WATER**;
 - CENTRAL AXIS) 5:18A AND THE PRIEST SHALL SET THE WOMAN BE-FORE YHVH, AND LET THE HAIR OF THE WOMAN'S HEAD GO LOOSE, AND PUT THE GRAIN OFFERING OF MEMORIAL IN HER HANDS, WHICH IS THE GRAIN OFFERING OF JEALOUSY;
 - 2A) 5:18B And the priest shall have in his hand THE WATER of bitterness that brings the curse;
 - 1c) 5:19a And the priest shall cause her to swear;
 - 1d) 5:19b And shall say to the woman, 'If no man has lain with you, and if you have not gone aside to uncleanness, being under your husband;
 - central axis) 5:19c Be free from this water of bitterness that brings the curse;

- 2d) 5:2022a But if you have gone aside, being under your husband, and if you are defiled, and some man has lain with you besides your husband—'21 then the priest shall cause the woman to swear with the oath of cursing, and the priest shall say to the woman—'YHVH make you a curse and an oath among your people, when YHVH makes your thigh to fall away, and your belly to swell; 22 and this water that brings the curse shall go into your bowels, and make your belly to swell, and your thigh to fall away;'

 - CENTRAL AXIS) 5:25-26 AND THE PRIEST SHALL TAKE THE GRAIN OF-FERING OF JEALOUSY OUT OF THE WOMAN'S HAND, AND SHALL WAVE THE GRAIN OFFERING BEFORE YHVH, AND BRING IT TO THE ALTAR. 26 AND THE PRIEST SHALL TAKE A HANDFUL OF THE GRAIN OFFERING, AS ITS MEMORIAL PART, AND MAKE IT SMOKE ON THE ALTAR, AND AFTERWARD SHALL MAKE THE WOMAN DRINK THE WATER:
 - 2A) 5:27-28 And when he has made her drink the water, then it shall come to pass, if she is defiled, and has acted unfaithfully against her husband, that THE WATER THAT BRINGS THE CURSE SHALL ENTER INTO HER AND BECOME BITTER, and her belly shall swell, and her thigh shall fall away; and the woman shall be a curse among her people. 28 And if the woman is not defiled, but is clean; then she shall be cleared, and shall conceive seed;
- 2a.1) 5:29 This is the law of jealousy, when a wife, being under her husband, goes aside, and is defiled;
- 2a.2) 5:30a Or when the spirit of jealousy comes upon a man, and he becomes jealous over his wife;
- 2a.3) 5:30b-31 Then shall he set the woman before YHVH, and the priest shall execute upon her all this law. 31 And the man shall be clear from iniquity, and that woman shall bear her iniquity; {p}
- 2B) 6:1-21 The law of the Nazirite who SEPARATES HIMSELF TO YHVH; {p}
 - 1a) 6:1-2 And YHVH spoke to Moses, saying, 2 "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them, 'When either man or woman shall clearly utter a vow, the vow of a Nazirite, to consecrate himself to YHVH;
 - **1b) 6:3-4 He shall abstain from wine** and strong drink; he shall drink no vinegar of wine, or vinegar of strong drink, neither shall he drink any liquor of grapes, nor eat fresh grapes or dried. **4** All the days of his Naziriteship he shall

- eat nothing that is made from the grapevine, from the pressed grapes, even to the grapeseed;
- 1c) 6:5 All the days of his vow of Naziriteship, no razor shall come on his head; until the days are fulfilled in which he consecrates himself to YHVH, he shall be holy, he shall let the locks of the hair of his head grow long;
- 1d) 6:6-12 All the days that he consecrates himself to YHVH, he shall not come near a dead body; however he shall bring his offerings and the priest shall make atonement for him;
 - 1A) 6:6A All THE DAYS THAT HE CONSECRATES HIMSELF TO YHVH;
 - 1B) 6:6B-8 He shall not come near to a dead body. 7 He shall not make himself unclean for his father, or for his mother, for his brother, or for his sister, when they die; because HIS CONSECRATION TO GOD IS ON HIS HEAD. 8 All the days of his Naziriteship he is holy to YHVH;
 - **1C) 6:9** And IF ANY MAN DIE VERY SUDDENLY BESIDE HIM, and he defiles his consecrated head, then he shall shave his head in the day of his cleansing, on the seventh day he shall shave it;
 - CENTRAL AXIS) 6:10-11A AND ON THE EIGHTH DAY HE SHALL BRING TWO TURTLEDOVES, OR TWO YOUNG PIGEONS, TO THE PRIEST, TO THE DOOR OF THE TENT OF MEETING. 11 AND THE PRIEST SHALL PREPARE ONE FOR A SIN OFFERING, AND THE OTHER FOR A BURNT OFFERING, AND MAKE ATONEMENT FOR HIM;
 - 2C) 6:11B Because he sinned BY REASON OF THE DEAD;
 - 2B) 6:11C And HE SHALL HALLOW HIS HEAD that same day;
 - 2A) 6:12 And HE SHALL CONSECRATE TO YHVH THE DAYS OF HIS NAZI-RITESHIP, and shall bring a male lamb of the first year for a trespass offering; but the former days shall be void, because his consecration was defiled;

central axis) 6:13a And this is the law of the Nazirite;

- 2d) 6:13b-17 When the days of his consecration are fulfilled, he shall offer his offerings;
 - 1A) 6:13B-15 He shall bring it to the door of the tent of meeting; and HE SHALL PRESENT HIS OFFERING TO YHVH, one male lamb of the first year without blemish for a burnt offering, and one female lamb of the first year without blemish for a sin offering, and one ram without blemish for peace offerings, 15 and a basket of unleavened bread, cakes of fine flour mingled with oil, and unleavened wafers spread with oil, and their grain offering, and their drink offerings;
 - CENTRAL AXIS) 6:16A AND THE PRIEST SHALL BRING THEM BEFORE YHVH:
