1A.1) 3:1-6A PARTAKERS of the heavenly calling;

1a) 3:1-2a Therefore, holy brothers, **partakers of the heavenly calling**, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, **Christ Jesus**; **2** who **was faithful to Him** who appointed Him;

1b) 3:2b As also **Moses was faithful in all His house**;

central axis) 3:3-4 For this Man was counted worthy of more glory than Moses, in as much as he who has built the house has more honor than the house. **4** For every house is built by some man; but he who built all things is God;

2b) 3:5 And truly **Moses was faithful in all His house**, as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken after;

2a) 3:6a But **Christ as a Son over His own house**;

1A.2) 3:6B Whose house we are, if we **HOLD FAST OUR CONFIDENCE** and the rejoicing of the hope firm **TO THE END**;

1B) 3:7 Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says, "**TODAY**, if you will hear His voice;

1C) 3:8-10 Do not **HARDEN YOUR HEARTS**;

1a) 3:8a **Do not harden your hearts**;

1b) 3:8b-9a As in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness, **9** when **your fathers** tempted Me, proved Me;

central axis) 3:9b And saw **My works forty years**;

2b) 3:10a Therefore I was grieved with **that generation**;

2a) 3:10b And said, 'They do always **err in their heart**; and they have not known My ways;'

CENTRAL AXIS) 3:11 SO I SWORE IN MY WRATH, 'THEY SHALL NOT ENTER INTO MY REST;'" [*Psa 95:7-11*]

2C) 3:12 Pay heed, brothers, lest there be in any of you an **EVIL HEART OF UNBELIEF**, in departing from the living God;

2B) 3:13 But exhort one another daily, while it is called '**TODAY**;' lest any of you become hardened through the deceitfulness of sin;

2A.1) 3:14A For we are made **PARTAKERS** of Christ;

2A.2) 3:14B-19 If we **HOLD** the beginning of **OUR CONFIDENCE STEADFAST TO THE END**;

1a) 3:14b-15 If we hold the beginning of our **confidence** steadfast to the end, **15** while it is said, "Today if you will hear His voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation;"

central axis) 3:16-18 For who, when they had heard, rebelled? Was it not all that came out of Egypt led by Moses? 17 But with whom was He grieved forty years? Was it not with those who had sinned, whose bodies fell in the wilderness? 18 And to whom did He swear that they should not enter into His rest, but to those who did not believe?

2a) 3:19 So we see that they could not enter in because of **unbelief**.
